## MONEY: Working for you? Or against you?



Money: many misquote the Bible and say that money is the *root of all evil* - 1Timothy 6:10 states; "For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows." Rarely are husband and wife naturally on the same page regarding money. Money works against the couple who don't understand their differences and utilize those differences together. Couples will almost always make better financial decisions when husbands and wives are in agreement. Yes, we may make a no-so-great decision together, but if we've made it together, there won't be the accusations and arguments that usually arise when one spouse makes a financial decision that didn't go according to plan. Too many couples argue about money and financial issues when they should be working together with their money.

Ron Blue wrote that money is to be a tool, a test, and a testimony. A tool to be used to help us navigate life and advance God's kingdom. A test of where our heart is - is God first? Or is money and possessions first in our lives. Finally, a testimony of what the Lord our God can do in us and through us as His people.
